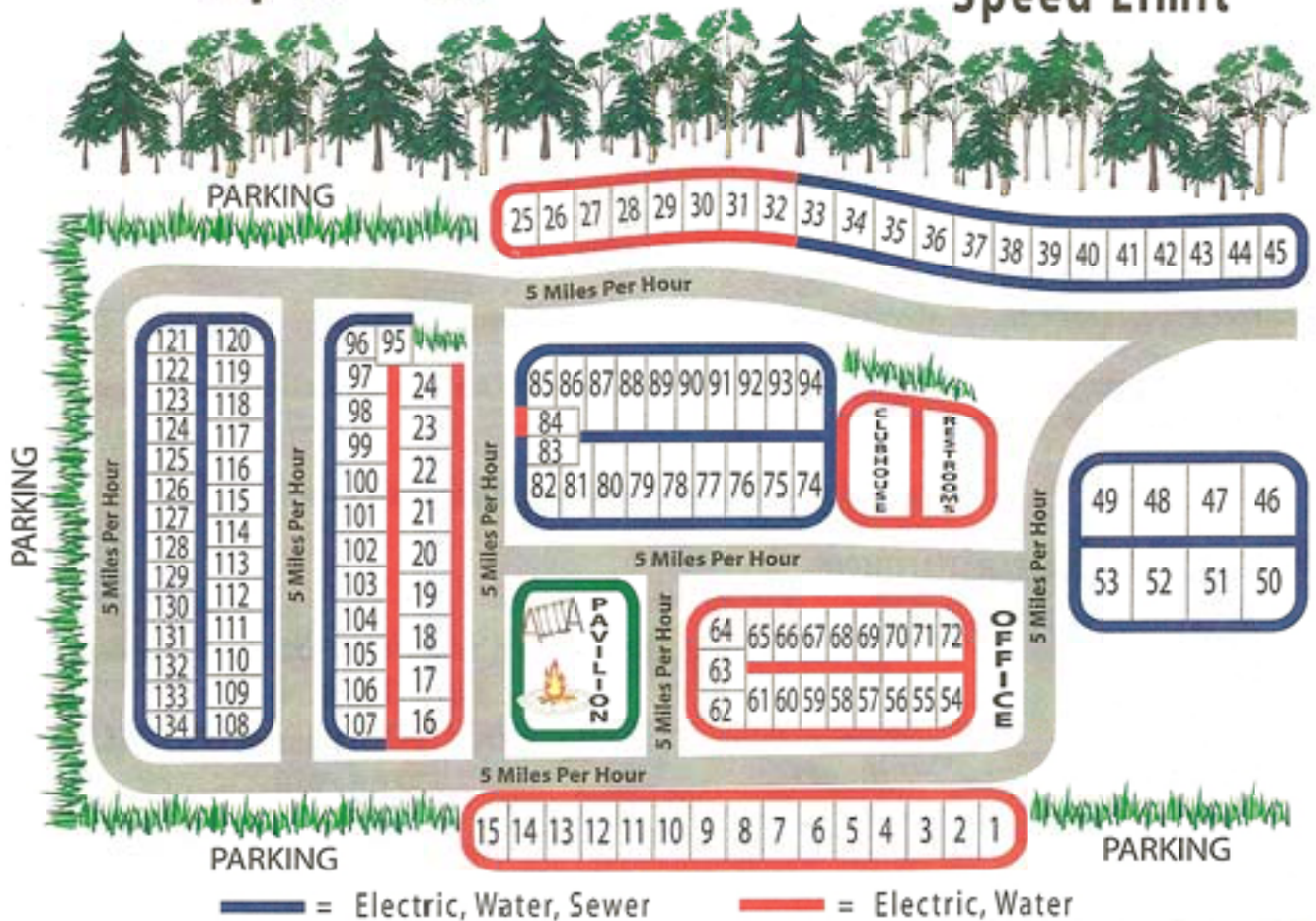

Park Rules

The conditions stated below will cover your conduct during the period covered by the camping permit. Your permit may be revoked without refund for violations of the Park Rules and Regulations, camping policy of these conditions:

1. Camping will be permitted only in established lots or areas designated by the park.
2. No lot or camp shall be occupied by more than one family.
3. Tent camping allowed by special permission only.
4. **Cars of campers and visitors must be parked off roads at all times.**
5. **Not more than one (1) car or similar component of transportation per campsite. Visitors or additional cars must be parked in designated parking lots.**
6. Quiet must be observed after 10:00 p.m. for the benefit of those who retire early.
7. Campsites must be cleaned up daily and waste, etc. deposited in containers provided.
8. All garbage must be wrapped in paper and placed in refuse containers.
9. Fires will be permitted in off ground containers only or in designated areas. Also, all fires must be extinguished upon retiring.
10. Dogs in park must be on leash.
11. Dog owners are required daily to clean up after their pets.
12. Containers must be kept under drains and emptied in designated places.
13. No juveniles can stay overnight in this park unless they are accompanied by a parent or guardian, have the permission of a parent or guardian or are part of an organized group.
14. The number of persons allowed at a campsite will not be more than six except for large families.
15. An extension to your permit must be obtained prior to noon of the day it expires.
16. Check out time is 12:00 noon. There will be a charge of additional day for late check out.
17. We reserve the right to request anyone to leave this campground for any reason the management deems necessary.
18. No mats or carpets larger than 18" x 24" may be placed on grass.
19. This card must be displayed in front window of unit.
20. No smoking in restrooms, shower rooms, meeting room or office.

Failure to conform with the above rules may result in loss of campsite usage.
